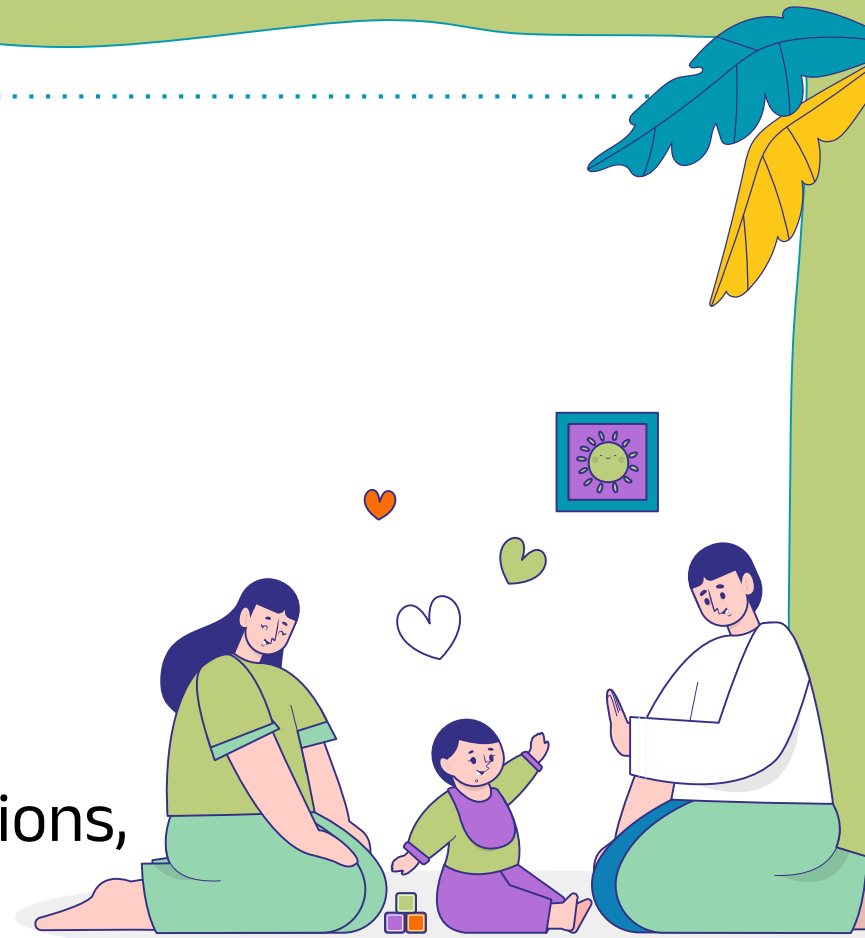

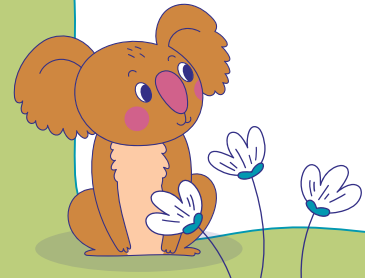


Lets understand Different definitions of Tarbiyah

Focused on Foundational values, emotional security, & early habits through love, care, & positive modeling.

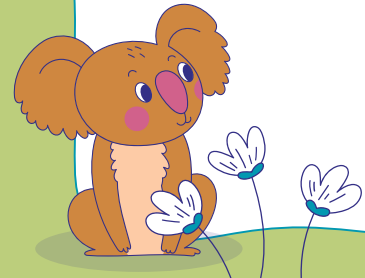


Lets understand Different definitions of Tarbiyah

Focused on Building character, developing understanding, & instilling discipline through structured learning & social experiences.

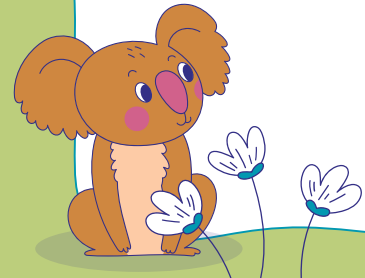


Lets understand Different definitions of Tarbiyah

Why Tarbiyah is a **Challenge**?

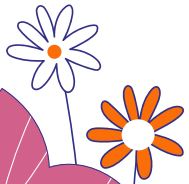
- Educational Institutions have successfully taught every student the Numbers, Grades, Ranks etc.

- We aren't trusting children rather we trust their **Marks, Numbers, Grades etc.**

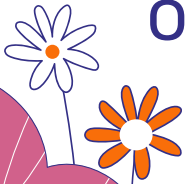


**Lets understand How to handle

Solution

1. Root Cause

2. Stay Calm

3. Set Clear Boundaries

4. Distract & Redirect

5. Consistency is Key

Topic	Importance of parents
I want my students to be able	To understand the importance of parents.
Skills/Values	Observation skills, sense of responsibility.
Materials I need to use	Nil

Activity:

Teacher does a role play showing the love and care of parents.

She enacts how parents take care of their child when they need them. Teacher can use the following situations:

1. When children get hurt.
2. When they don't complete their homework.
3. When the children need something to eat or wear.

Teacher to make children understand the importance of being kind and obedient towards their parents.

Note: 1) The teacher can continue further if she can manage according to time limit.

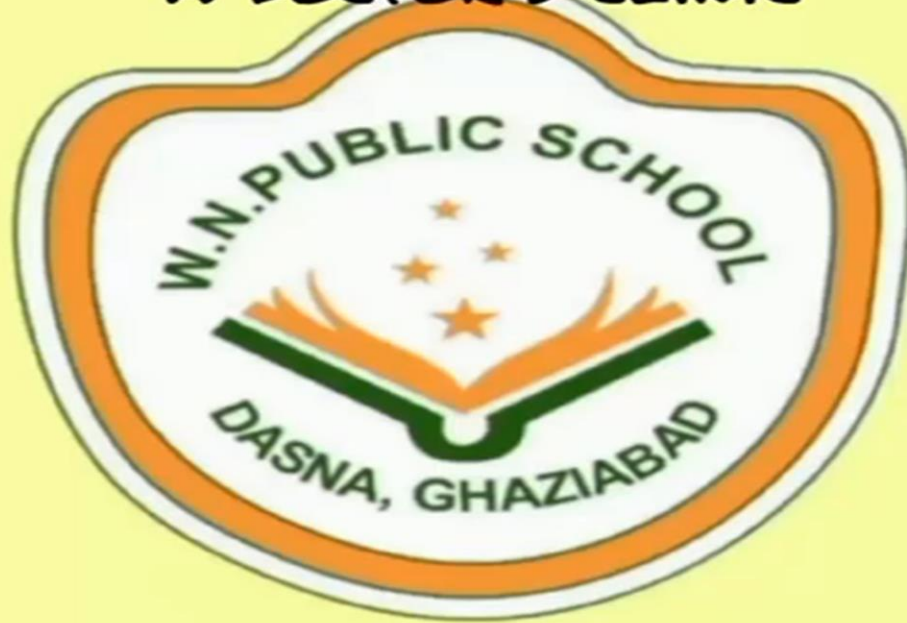
2) Teacher needs to enact both the character of a mother and as well the child. (As it's day 1) In case the teacher has any substitute she can include her also by giving her a character.
